<b>InTASC Standards</b>
<b>The Learner and Learning</b>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>InTASC 1 Learner Development:</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Understands how learners grow, develop, varying patterns of learning and development across cognitive, linguistic, social, emotional and physical areas and designs and implements developmentally appropriate and challenging learning experiences.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>InTASC 2 Learning Differences</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Uses understanding of individual differences and diverse cultures and communities to ensure inclusive learning environments that enable each learner to meet high standards.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>InTASC 3 Learning Environments</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Works with others to create environments that support individual and collaborative learning and that encourage positive social interaction, active engagement in learning and self-motivation.</p>
<b>Content Knowledge</b>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>InTASC 4 Content Knowledge</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Understands the central concepts, tools of inquiry, and structures of the disciplines he or she teaches and creates learning experiences that make these aspects of the discipline accessible and meaningful for learners to assure mastery of content.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>InTASC 5 Application of Content</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Understands how to connect concepts and use differing perspectives to engage learners in critical thinking, creativity and collaborative problem solving related to authentic local and global issues.</p>
<b>Instructional Practice</b>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>InTASC 6 Assessment</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Understands and uses multiple methods of assessment to engage learners in their own growth, to monitor learner progress and to guide the teacher's and learner's decision making.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>InTASC 7 Planning for Instruction</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Plans instruction that supports every student in meeting rigorous learning goals by drawing upon knowledge of content areas, curriculum, cross-disciplinary skills and pedagogy, as well as knowledge of learners and the community context.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>InTASC 8 Instructional Strategies</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Understands and uses a variety of instructional strategies to encourage learners to develop deep understanding of content areas and their connections and to build skills to apply knowledge in meaningful ways.</p>
<b>Professional Responsibility</b>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>InTASC 9 Professional Learning and Ethical Practice</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Engages in ongoing professional learning and uses evidence to continually evaluate his/her practice, particularly the effects of his/her choices and actions on others (learners, families, other professionals, and the community) and adapts practice to meet the needs of each learner.</p>
